The International Workshop on Language Production (IWOLP) is a biennial conference series and one of the most prestigious venues in cognitive science for research on how the brain produces language. Since its inaugural meeting in Marseille in 2004, IWOLP has brought together leading scholars across linguistics, psychology, neuroscience, and computer science for keynote talks, poster sessions, and parallel sessions on topics from lexical selection and syntactic encoding to bilingual production, monitoring, and multimodal communication.

- how cognitive, neural, and computational mechanisms account for language production in multilingual settings.

We are currently accepting abstract submissions (up to 300 words) for poster presentations.

Selected contributions may later be invited for publication in a special issue of *Language, Cognition and Neuroscience*.
